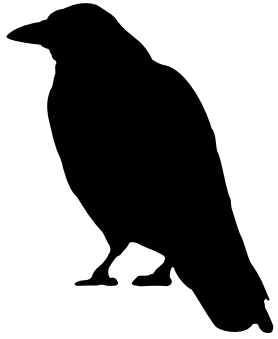
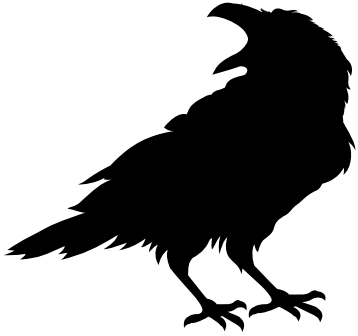


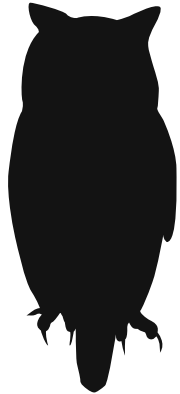


Owls, Ravens & Crows - Oh my!

Crow: CAW!, black, diurnal, often found in groups, often found in cities, omnivore. Raven: CROAK!, black, diurnal, often found in pairs, omnivore. Owl: HOOT!, sharp talons for catching prey, often found alone, nocturnal, ear-like feathers atop head, brown (often with black or white marks), very good night vision, carnivore, sharp curved beak
